




VERTICAL PINE SIDING

BOARD & BATTEN

- Pine Board siding
- 3/4" x 2" Pine Battens cover up any gaps between the boards.
- Board & Batten is our most popular & default siding choice on many designs.

PINE BOARD

- Rough Sawn 1" thick Eastern White Knotty Pine
- Basic, Economical


Alternate Siding

Additional option for woodbins. Promotes airflow for drying firewood



SHIPLAP

- 7/8" thick Eastern White Knotty Pine that can be installed horizontally or vertically
- Lapped boards join together providing a flat surface, free of gaps
- One side is smooth one side is rough can be installed to meet your preference



Saltbox Design

Eastern White Pine

Native to New England, low-maintenance and rapid growth makes Eastern White Pine (*Pinus strobus*) a sustainable and economical choice. It's known to be relatively easy to work with.

Newly cut and milled pine lumber is a rather pale straw color and weathers to a distinct brownish gray.

Paint it Up!

Preserve your building and show off your personality by applying some paint. Go for a conventional color palette to match your existing home, or have fun with a multicolored masterpiece that will make your garden pop with vivid hues.

If you want to enhance the wood grain, stain your building or apply a linseed oil once every five years.


HORIZONTAL PINE SIDING

LOG CABIN

- 2" thick with a 6" Profile
- Eastern White Knotty Pine
- Rounded shape mimics the look of a log cabin



PINE NOVELTY

- 3/4" thick Eastern White Knotty Pine
- Boards cut with an extended lap that mimics clapboard
- Can be installed horizontally or vertically




ADIRONDACK

- Live-edge boards achieve rustic style

- 3/4" thick Eastern White Knotty Pine
- Comes with additional wall framing


CEDAR SIDING

Resilient, elegant and sustainably sourced from North America.



WHITE CEDAR SHINGLES

- Approximately 3/4" thick White Cedar Shingles
- Stain, paint or leave be to achieve rustic graying
- Knotty pine board is used as a base layer
- White Cedar (*Thuja occidentalis*) is sourced from Atlantic Northeast.

RED CEDAR SHINGLES

- Approximately 3/4" thick Western Red Cedar Shingles
- Naturally resistant to rain and snow
- Knotty pine board is used as a base layer



Straight refined edges



RED CEDAR CLAPBOARD

- 3/4" thick Western Red Cedar Clapboards
- Comes with a base layer of rough sawn pine board siding for installation



RED CEDAR SHAKES

- 1 1/4" thick Hand Split Western Red Cedar Shakes
- Resistant to weather with a rustic, woodland feel
- Knotty pine board is used as a base layer

The Benefits of Red Cedar

Western Red Cedar (*Thuja plicata*) is durable and resistant to rot making it an ideal siding choice for sheds and cottages. Extractives found in the heartwood stop decay in its tracks by fending off fungi. Many building codes rate red cedar highly due to its durability. It is an eco-friendly choice for exterior use because preservative treatments are not necessary.

The fine, straight grain of this material means it is easy to cut and nail with minimal splitting. Red cedar can be easily sawn with basic hand or power tools. Fasteners rarely split red cedar when it is being attached to your building. If a smoother surface is needed cedar can be planed to fit or match any pattern or profile. Red Cedar is sourced from Pacific Northwest.
